HIGH SCHOOL OFFERINGS

- Courses will be located at the Findlay High School freshman wing.
- All Physical Education classes will be held at Donnell Middle School.
- Findlay City School residents that attend FCS or live in the school district will pay \$105 per course. If you are a non-resident the cost is \$135 per course. For Credit Recovery Courses the cost is \$60 per course.
- Classes must have a minimum of 14 students to be held. Classes that do not reach the minimum enrollment will be cancelled and students will be informed as soon as possible.
- If requested session is full, you will be placed in the next available session.
- Findlay students will be given priority over non-district students regarding space availability.

TRADITIONAL COURSES: Taken with an instructor to supplement high school schedule.

CREDIT RECOVERY COURSE: Computer Based Online course taken for students who have previously enrolled and completed the course but did not earn credit.

Courses offered through the Plato program in summer school for credit recovery: Government, American History, Economics, Biology, English 9,10,11,12, Algebra I, II, Geometry, Global Science, Global Studies, Integrated Science, and Physical Science. Students are only able to enroll in one course at a time. Students will be enrolled in a course to earn .5 (1/2) credit at a time. After completion of the course, the student may request to take an additional course. Placement in additional courses will be dependent upon open space at that time. The lab will be open for two timeframes from 8 a.m.-10:30 a.m., 10:30 a.m. -1:00 p.m., if an additional session is needed, it will be scheduled from 2:00p.m -4:30 p.m. Space is limited per session.

COSMETOLOGY: A Cosmetology class will be held at Millstream. This class is a prerequisite for 11th and 12th grade cosmetology students. The dates for this class are **June 5 – 30, 2017 from 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.** The cost is \$200. There is also an additional \$40.00 (approx.) fee cost that will be paid separately to purchase a kit from Millstream Cosmetology. For more information please call (419) 420-3357.

Middle School Course fees

Findlay City School residents that attend FCS or live in the school district the will pay \$60 per course. If you are a non- resident the cost is \$75 per course.

GRADE PROCEDURE/ATTENDANCE: Grades will be given to the student on the last day of class. A copy will be mailed home within five days of the end of summer school. Grades will not be released if fees are unpaid. There are very STRICT attendance regulations for middle and high school students in summer school. Parents should not register their children if vacations, camps, and other activities conflict with summer school dates. No PE waivers or Educational Options will be granted for camps of any type.

REFUND POLICY: Refunds are only made through the end of the first week of classes. Refunds will be mailed to the student’s home. **Summer school fees are not subject to standard fee waivers.**
